FILM BOOTCAMP: The fundamentals of film making

July 20 - 23; 8:00 am—7:00 pm

\$100; Ages 15+; Applications due July 11; Limited to the first 18 applicants

DESCRIPTION: Now in its 4th year, Sage Studio's Film Boot Camp not only teaches the filmmaking process but supplies mentored, hands-on training culminating in the creation of 2-3 short films. This "double-duty" exposes the student to a broad view of filmmaking, teaching them how all aspects influence a film shoot. The films will be debuted for students, their families and the public during the film portion of FOCUS 2011 (July 23) — an event showcasing the talents of our community's youth.

INSTRUCTORS: Tom Stern: Tom is an independent filmmaker who has directed, co-wrote, and produced feature and short films like *This Is A Business*. Most notably, Tom's award-winning short film *The Autobiography of Tom Stern, Chapter Six: The New Science* was named by renowned indie filmmaker Hal Hartley to the Best of 2007 line-up in Microcinema International's traveling screening series *Independent Exposure 2007*. Tom holds an M.F.A. in Film Production from Chapman University and a B.A. in Philosophy from Eckerd College.

Dan Stern: Dan has produced feature films, shorts, commercials, and made-for-internet content. He has many accomplishments, including his script *The Rebound Guy* which finished in the Top 4 of Project Greenlight 2 (contest sponsored by Matt Damon & Ben Affleck). He holds an MFA in acting from the Actors Studio Drama School and his BA is in English Literature and Theatre from Wake Forest University. He is also a current member of the Screen Actors Guild (SAG).

DESCRIPTION: Sage Studio Theatre and Comedy Camp is an intensive 3 week course with an emphasis on building ensemble unity, individual acting development, vocal enhancement and stage movement. The first week will be dedicated to theatre and the final two will incorporate the element of comedic improv. Participants will write and act in classic theatre and in pieces they create themselves. They will have an opportunity to explore their own vision in a creative, supportive environment. There will be a final showcase presented at the end of the three weeks that is created by the students and their instructors.

INSTRUCTORS: Pat McGann: Stand-up comedian Pat is the House MC at the legendary Zanies Comedy Club and the creator and host of the television show *The Chicago Stand-Up Project*. In 2010, Pat was among the country's top comedians invited to perform at The Great American Comedy Festival.

Kate Wilford: Kate graduated from Augustana College and began working at Raue Center four years ago coordinating Sage Studio, Mission Imagination educational programming, and many more operations. This is her third year teaching Sage Studio Theatre Camp.
