Williams Street Repertory, the in-house professional theatre company at Raue Center for the Arts. Students will explore all aspects of classic and modern musical theatre, with a focus on the three core performance disciplines unique to the genre—acting, singing, and dance. With special sessions on audition technique, improvisation, movement and vocal health, as well as guest instructors including veterans of the Chicago and New York theatre scene, this class is a true immersive experience for young performers, helping them to develop as artists and young theatre professionals—and a must for any student with plans to pursue a theatre career. This workshop culminates in a showcase of songs and scenes on the stage of the Raue Center for the Arts!

**PREREQUISITES:** Students must exhibit an appreciation and aptitude for musical theatre. Students are also required to submit a video audition of a musical theatre song (no more than three minutes)—this can be accompanied or a capella.
