He has lately been busy recording an album of original songs, under the band name "Rolling Numbers," which is soon to be released. Many of the same musicians from the Petty Kings perform on the album.



Jessica Hornsten is a versatile vocalist with a classical and musical theater background. When she's not singing with the Petty Kings or Rolling Numbers, you will find her performing in Deacon Blues, Big Suit, Golden Richards, or as Joni Mitchell in the latest SoundTracks Of A Generation shows Desert Rock and The Last Waltz. Jess has also performed in other SoundTracks tributes including The Mad Dogs & Englishmen Tour, Joe Cocker Tribute, Woodstock Era, The Soul Commitments and Summer of Love 1967. Recent venues include the Park West, City Winery, Navy Pier, and Buddy Guy's Legends.



Dave Steffen is the peoples' guitar player. Called the "Swiss Army Knife" guitar player for his ability to play different stringed instruments, or the "Parts Guy" for finding good guitar hooks, or "The Closer" for being able to adding soulful parts that elevate a band or song to a higher level, Steffen is a sonic presence that pulls you in!
