I understand that I must complete an Artist Statement electronically for my submission. I further understand that there are no restrictions on subject matter or mediums, but I agree to follow the guidelines so my work of art can be included in the **6 x 6 PROJECT**.

I will deliver my completed canvas **no later than May 13, 2025** to Raue Center For The Arts, 26 N. Williams Street, Crystal Lake, IL 60014, during business hours **OR** one of the following partner locations:

Submission Guidelines

- **All artwork must be ORIGINAL work of the artist** and be created on a 6" x 6" canvas obtained from Raue Center or a partner location. **No other canvases will be accepted.** Up to two (2) canvases can be submitted per artist. Raue Center reserves the right to reject any artwork it deems inappropriate or that does not follow guidelines.
- Art can be mounted to the front of canvas, but **no part can be outside the perimeter (i.e., hanging off edge, glued/attached to the sides)**. All mediums are allowed (i.e., any kind of paint, ink, photography, pencil, mixed media, clay, etc.). **DO NOT cover up the number on back of canvas.**
- Artwork should be **no more than 5 pounds**. All canvases will be exhibited in square format, not as a diamond (diagonally). Please mark "top" or "bottom" on back of canvas so artwork can be hung correctly if it's not obvious. **NO hangers on back of canvas please.**
- Mediums that could smear (i.e., charcoal, pastels, etc.), **MUST have artwork sealed** prior to submission. **NO LOOSE GLITTER** (glitter in paint is acceptable). If using oils, please make sure canvas is **completely dry** before submitting. Use a good adhesive if attaching items to canvas in any way. We are not responsible for any damage that may happen if these recommendations are not followed.
- **Sign your work**, either on the back of the canvas/frame or on the front.
- **Create an Artist Statement** – The link to create an artist statement is <https://www.rauecenter.org/6x6-artist-call/> and is also available at the Raue Center website. Make sure to have your canvas number to correspond with your art. We ask you to provide at minimum, a Title and Medium(s) used (i.e., Sunflower, Acrylic; First Sign of Spring, Watercolor, etc) for your art. **Artist statements are due by May 20, 2025.**
- Please **check business hours for each location** before going to pick up or drop off canvases.
- Canvases cannot be transferred to another individual. If you are unable to complete your canvas, please contact us before the deadline or return canvas to Raue Center's box office.
- **IMPORTANT!** Please add 6x6project@rauecenter.org to your email contacts as **updates via email and other important information will be sent periodically.** You can also check [Facebook.com/6x6project](https://www.facebook.com/6x6project) for information.
- All donated art will be sold in an on-line auction, which will be from **June 1 to June 14, 2025**, to the highest bidder. *We encourage you to let family and friends know you're participating so they can see/bid on your art. **Any art that is NOT bid on will remain the property of Raue Center and may be used in the venue or elsewhere.***
